County Commissioners Report

Monday the 22nd of July 2013 I interviewed a Stanly County Commissioner Peter Ascitutto. At first, I had no idea what the duties of a County Commissioner were. The commissioners just finished with the tax budget with no tax increase for property owners. Now, they are working together for a new radio system which is an 8 million dollar project and they must figure a way to pay for it. Mr. Ascitutto has served on the board for seven months. To learn about the County Government Mr. Ascitutto goes around monthly working with various departments. He worked with the animal control setting traps for dogs and cats. He also went to work with the health department doing health inspections at local restaurants. As a County Commissioner he tries to work in all aspects of the government to get feel for what's going on in the community and to make better decisions. One of the toughest decisions he had to make was with a 5million dollar lawsuit with ALCOA with the relicensing of the dam. A settlement was made with ALCOA to move on. Another was the animal control ordinance. The health department wanted a leash law for the county after 5 months the ordinance was passed. I was completely amazed at all the things they have to deal with and how long it takes for the
